


BACK TO SCHOOL

North Kansas City School District Elementray Schools Back to School Night is Monday, August 12. from 4:30-7pm. Winnetonka High School will host their Meet the Teacher Night on Monday, Aug. 19, beginning at 6 p.m. at the school. The first day of school is Wednesday, August 14. With the start of the 2013-2014 academic year, all elementary schools will

follow a **slightly different bell schedule**. Four days a week (*Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday*) will be 10 minutes longer, and one day a week (*Thursday*) will be shorter. For Chapel Hill Elementary, the Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday school day will be 9:15-4:10, with Thursday being 9:15-3:35. This system has been in place at the middle schools and high schools for several years.

There are several ways in which you may give your American flag the proper retirement without showing disgrace to this great country. If you would like to dispose of the flag yourself then the most fitting way is to hold your own, private ceremony. The U.S. Flag Code states, "The flag, when it is in such a condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem for display, should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferable by burning." After your flag has been burned, the ashes should be buried. If you cannot burn and bury the flag yourself, then there are several organizations that will retire your flag in a proper and respectful ceremony. Among them are:
