Nursery/2's & 3's

During the month of February, little ones will learn that Jesus is the best teacher because He teaches us how to live God's way. When we obey Jesus, it's like building a house on a super strong rock. They will focus on the memory verse, "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord.' That is what I am..." John 13:13

Pre-K/Kindergarten & Elementary

February 6th: This week, kids will learn about how and why Jesus called the disciples. They will learn that following Jesus is the opposite of following ourselves.

February 13th: This week, kids will learn what Jesus had to say about blessings and woes. They will learn that our struggles bring us closer to Jesus

February 20th: This week, kids will learn that Jesus wants us to love our enemies. They will learn that our enemies help us learn to love.

February 27th: *Pre-K/Kindergarten* kids will learn who Jesus is through the transfiguration. They will learn that Jesus is with us even though we can't see him.

February 27th: *Elementary* kids will be learning the same thing as the adults for Vision Sunday. They will learn about the Old Covenant/Old Creation vs. the New Covenant/New Creation.
